## 1/ Welcome to the French political system

France operates as a unitary semi-presidential republic, where power is divided between a president, a prime minister, and a bicameral parliament composed of two chambers : the Senate and The National Assembly.

The President of France (currently Emmanuel Macron) is the head of state and is elected by popular vote for a five-year term. The president holds significant executive powers, including appointing the prime minister and serving as the commander-in-chief of the armed forces. As for the Prime Minister, he is the head of government and he leads the Council of Ministers, sets government policy, and oversees the implementation of laws.

Furthermore, France has a multi-party system with several major political parties representing a range of ideologies, including center-right, center-left, and far-right parties. The two main parties historically have been The Republicans (formerly the Union for a Popular Movement) on the right and the Socialist Party on the left.

## 2/ What is France's position on the matter?

As a former member of the European Union since its inception with the signing of the Treaty of Rome on March 25th 1957 we are delighted to declare that France has always and will always be for peace.
